If a player is in breach then his parents/guardians will be informed immediately.**

### PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:

#### OBLIGATIONS TOWARDS THE GAME

##### A PLAYER SHOULD:

- MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO DEVELOP HIS OWN SPORTING ABILITIES, IN TERMS OF SKILLS, TECHNIQUE, TACTICS AND STAMINA.
- GIVE MAXIMUM EFFORT AND STRIVE FOR THE BEST POSSIBLE PERFORMANCE DURING A GAME, EVEN IF HIS TEAM IS IN A POSITION WHERE THE DESIRED RESULT HAS ALREADY BEEN ACHIVED.
- AVOID ALL FORMS OF GAMESMANSHIP, AND TIME WASTING
- NOT USE INAPPROPRIATE LANGUAGE
- NOT BULLY OTHER PLAYERS, WHETHER INSIDE THE CLUB OR OPPONENTS
- PLAY WITHIN THE RULES, REMEMBERING FAIR PLAY AT ALL TIME
- ABIDE BY THE LAWS, RULES AND SPIRIT OF THE GAME, AND THE COMPETITION RULES

- ACCEPT FAILURE, VICTORY DEFEAT, EQUALLY
- TREAT OPPONENTS WITH DUE RESPECT AT ALL TIME, IRRESPECTIVE OF THE RESULT OF THE GAME
- SAFEGUARD THE PHYSICAL FITNESS OF OPPONENTS, AVOID VIOLENCE AND ROUGH PLAY, AND HELP INJURED OPPONENTS
- ACCEPT THE DECISION OF THE MATCH OFFICIAL WITHOUT PROTEST
- AVOID WORDS OR ACTIONS WHICH MAY MISLEAD A MATCH OFFICIAL
- SHOW DUE RESPECT TOWARDS MATCH OFFICIALS
- ABIDE BY THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE COACH AND TEAM OFFICIALS, PROVIDED THEY DO NOT CONTRADICT THE SPIRIT OF THIS CODE.
- SHOW RESPECT TOWARDS THE TEAM OFFICIALS OF THE OPPOSITION
- SHOW DUE RESPECT TO THE INTERESTS OF THE SUPPORTERS.
